## General waste

- · Diapers, sanitary pads and cotton swabs
- · Contaminated packaing
- Vacuum cleaner bags
- Pizza boxes
- Wrappers from snacks
- Baking paper

Put the waste in a bag and tie with a knot.

### **X** Food waste

- Cheese and dairy products
- Tea bags and coffee filters with arounds
- Fish, meat, toppings and bones
- Vegetables and fruit
- Bread, cakes, rice, pasta and sauce
- Bouquet of flowers

Put the waste in a bad and tie with a knot.

#### Food- & drink cartons

- · Empty cartons from milk, juice and beans
- · Empty food cartons i.e from
- creme and ice cream

- Empty food jars
- Marmelade and
- Wine bottles

Empty glass and bottles must be handed in glass cubes or at the recycling centers

#### Metal

- Tins from beer and soft drinks
- · Aluminum trays and foil
- Food tins
- Used tealight holders
- Metal lids



Place the empty

packaging loose in the container.

#### Plastic

- · Plastic bags, plastic foil and bubble wrap
- Toys without

- Plastic trays

Place the empty packaging loose in the container.



#### Paper

- Newspapers and magazines
- Brochures
- Letters and envelopes
- Books without spines
- Bags of paper
- Clean paper in generel



Must be clean and dry. Place loose in the container.

#### Cardboard

- Cardboard tubes from
- Small cardboard boxes
- Egg boxes
- Shoe boxes



Must be clean and dry Place loose in the container

### \Lambda Hazardous waste

- Small electronic devises
- Nail polish- and remover
- Paint and oil residues
- Sprav bottles
- Batteries
- Chemicals
- Termometers
- Liaht bulbs

Place in the red environmetal box.
